- **Synchronous (Live Classes):** Perfect for students who thrive with a set schedule and lots of teacher interaction.
- **Asynchronous (Flexible Schedule):** Ideal for self-motivated, independent learners who like to set their own pace and have flexibility in their schedule.

Grade 10 – 12 – Join Us for an Exciting New School Year – Registration is Open!

Full-time online students can reach out to your Sask DLC Academic Advisor or your school counsellor to discuss the classes that interest you and how they fit your

graduation plan. You are encouraged to **register by June 30** so you don't have to worry about it throughout the summer and you'll be ready to go in the Fall. You will have access to your courses in DLCgo.ca on the first day of school, September 3.

Part-time online students can contact their local school Principal or Guidance Counsellor to discuss course options that fit your schedule and your graduation plan for next year.

New this year: Three Exciting Elective Courses to Expand Your Options!

- **Football Skills 10L** (elective): introduces the basic concept of football while developing fitness levels, mental training and leadership skills
- **Baseball Skills 10L, 20L, 30L** (elective): introduces you to the basics of baseball and guides you through intermediate and advanced techniques in throwing, fielding, hitting, pitching, leadership, baserunning, coaching and more! 30L is only offered in semester 2.
- **Oil & Gas 20** (PAA or elective): you will learn about energy exploration, production, environmental stewardship, economic impacts and more!
